

GDPR Document N.S.D.V Trivium

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NSDV Trivium processes personal data for:

- Maintaining a membership register;
- Collecting dues and other payments made on behalf of members;
- Keeping track of debate progress of members during meetings;
- Sending periodic information about association activities to members;
- Making video or photo recordings during events;
- Registering members for events.

For this purpose, the following personal data are processed:

- Name and first name;
- Date of birth;
- Student number and institution;
- Bank details;
- Dietary preferences, sleeping preferences and any entry requirements only for those members for whom this is relevant for events.

Personal data is accessible to:

- The Board, to the extent necessary for the performance of their duties;
- The Board may share this information with committees when they estimate that it is necessary for committees to perform their duties;
- The Board may share this information with third parties only to achieve a purpose for which it processes personal data as defined in this document;
- The Board may not share personal data with individual members unless it is the personal data of that particular member.

If information is shared with third parties, the information sharing will be made transparent in a Processing Register. Any data processing will in principle be included in the Processing Register.

If a data breach occurs:

- The Board will inform the affected individuals of the data breach;
- The Board will record this data breach in a data breach register;
- The Board will do its utmost to prevent this data breach in the future.

If members wish, they can submit a request for removal or unrecognizability. In principle, the Board will comply with this request.
